Dear Parents/Carers,

Re: Year 11 NCFE Cache Child Development and Care Coursework

I am taking this opportunity to provide further information following the recent DfE announcement and Mr Hogarth's letter confirming how results will be awarded this series for the traditional GCSE's.

The course which we study at Raynes Park High School is a professional qualification called NCFE Cache Child Development and Care. This is a vocational qualification and comprises of coursework and external examination. Students complete coursework throughout the course and, therefore, we have been informed that the exam board moderation process will continue.

This means all students are required to submit their two coursework units to the moderator in order for the units to be awarded a grade. This coursework needs to be completed to the best of students' ability as evidence of their current grade and achievements. Without coursework units submitted, the exam board will not be able to award grades and a qualification for this subject.

Our final internal deadlines, which a number of students have missed, were:

Unit 2: Monday 23rd March

Unit 1: Tuesday 31st March

Many opportunities were provided for students to complete the work and act on feedback to make improvements with additional interventions, lesson time and school holiday intervention.

Therefore, complete coursework units with corrections are needed urgently in order that we are able to submit these to the exam board. I am asking that all students and parents be aware of how important completion of these units is and to ensure students are regularly checking SMHW for my correspondence and that all coursework is sent to my school email address rpugh@raynespark.merton.sch.uk
