Dear Families,

As you will be aware, there have been a number of government announcements this week, including further information about the wider reopening of secondary schools.

Following the announcement last night that all five scientific tests have been met, we can continue with our preparations to re-open for some 'face to face support' for Year 10 and Year 12 from Monday 15th June. This will include completion of a thorough risk assessment that has been circulated by the Local Authority and a detailed re-opening plan that will be shared and agreed before we reopen by our Governing Body.

When we have finalised our plans to reopen, we will write to confirm the timetable for any face to face delivery and we have sent a survey to Year 10 and Year 12 families regarding the return of these year groups. Thank you so much indeed to those of you who have already completed this; however, the survey doesn't close until Monday 1st June, so there is still time to complete this and your feedback really is invaluable.

If your child is not in one of these year groups but you would like to speak to someone at the school, please don't hesitate to contact us.

We will continue to provide remote learning for students in Key Stage 3 and will remain open for the children of key workers and other targeted groups.

I hope that you have managed to enjoy the sun this week and we look forward to welcoming more students back to school as soon as it is safe to do so.
