All GCSE text books and revision guides will be available for payment for current Year 9 students in Scopay, but the ones needed for your child will depend on their chosen subjects for GCSEs; please check which books are required before placing an order.

If you would like to purchase any of these books through the school, please reserve your copies by making a payment through Scopay before Wednesday 1st July. We aim to deliver your books at the start of the new term in September and they can be collected from the Finance Office.

If your child is eligible for the Pupil Premium Grant or Free School Meals, the school will be able to contribute 50% (PP) or 90% (FSM) of the total payment; please simply deduct this amount when placing your order.
