


Education Wellbeing Service Parent Webinar Series – what did parents say?

Session title: Understanding and Supporting your Teen with Autism


Session dates: Monday 15th of January & Wednesday 24th of January

There is a lot of 'generic' information about child development - I was interested in how I, as a neurotypical adult, can help and understand my autistic child.


I would really be interested in a webinar for High Functioning Autism - a lot of information about autism concentrates on the less able people. My son is in a grammar school so performs very well on
