- Inform the school of the reason for absence on the first day using the SIMS parent app
- Ensure that holidays are taken during the school holidays
- Inform the school of any change in home circumstances that may affect my child
- Inform the school of any change to home contact details via the SIMS parent app
- Ensure that all communication with the school is undertaken in a respectful manner
- Attend Consultation Evenings and other relevant events
- Monitor the completion of my child's homework using the homework platform
- Monitor my child's rewards, behaviour points and attendance using the SIMS parent app

As a student I will:

- Attend school every day and arrive by 8.30am
- Wear the correct school uniform at all times; including to and from school
- Be punctual to lessons with the correct books and equipment
- Complete all classwork to the best of my ability and complete homework on time
- Follow the RPHS behaviour code and behave in a way that does not disrupt the calm order of the school
- Not prevent other students from learning, or staff from teaching
- Have respect for others and their property within school
- Not use threatening, offensive or sexually explicit language

- Not bully, threaten, be aggressive or unkind to others
