


## Students: Using Assignments and Viewing Feedback

If you are set an assignment on Teams there are a number of ways you can access it. You will receive a notification on Teams (blue oval) which you can click directly on. You can also go directly to the class which you have been set an assignment for and click on **Assignments** from the menu at the top of that page (yellow oval).



To view all your assignments in one place click on **Assignments** from the menu on the left in Teams (red oval). This will bring up a list of all the assignments you still need to do (**Assigned**) and all the ones that you have handed in (**Completed**). You can see the name of each assignment and the date and time it is due (green oval).

Select the assignment you are going to work on to see the instructions for that task. Each assignment will be different and you will need to read the instructions carefully, see below for examples. Whatever the assignment you must click **Hand in** when you are ready.

Assignments might involve:

- Completing a quiz online
- Answering questions on a word document provided
- Completing work on a computer and then uploading the finished file
- Completing written work and uploading a picture of it




