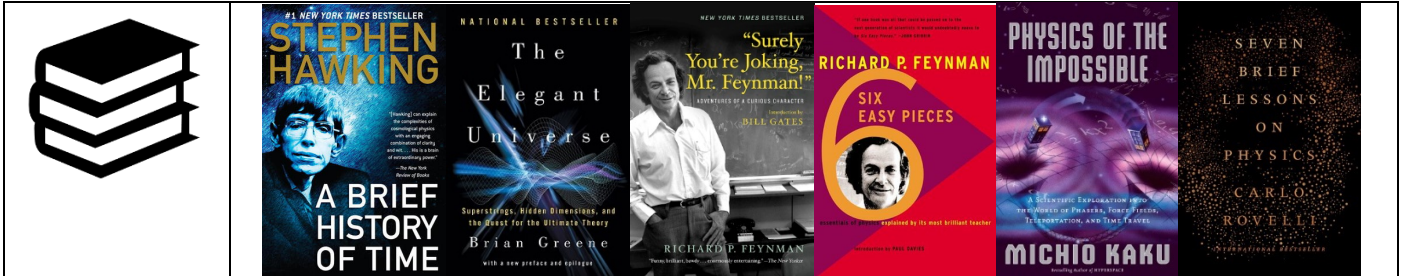


# ONCE A PHYSICIST, ALWAYS A PHYSICIST!
