



KS3 Curriculum Information (Years 7 and 8)

Throughout KS3, History is taught by a member of the humanities team with students receiving three lessons per fortnight. A wide variety of topics are studied as part of the History curriculum with a focus on developing the skills needed to succeed at GCSE.

KS4 Curriculum Information (Years 9, 10 and 11)

The study of History at Key Stage 4 begins in Year 9. Students will follow the Edexcel 9-1 GCSE programme of study which includes a range of challenging and engaging topics from 'International Relations, 1945-1991' to 'Medicine through Time'.

Extended Learning

Students are offered booster revision classes leading up to GSCEs. These can take the form of afterschool sessions, Saturday school or holiday intervention.

Ways Families can Help Support

All year 7 students are encouraged to watch historical documentaries in subjects that we are studying. Students should also be encouraged to take part in visits to museums that will bring the topics to life.


