KS4 Curriculum Information

The Key Stage 4 course has been developed to recognise learner's skills, knowledge and understanding of Health, Social Care and the Early Years sector. The aims are to develop your skills, knowledge and understanding in contexts that are directly relevant to employment situations, thereby enhancing employability within the health and social care sector and enabling you to access further education programmes or occupational training on a full-time or part-time basis. The topics covered in KS4: Basic first aid, Life stages, Effective communication in an early years setting and essential care values.

KS5 Curriculum Information

The Key Stage 5 course allows for greater flexibility with choices through a wide range of units such as learning about an individual's rights and needs, cultural diversity, sexual health and contraception, and coping with changes in life stages. It is an ideal foundation for students entering the workplace, providing them with a theoretical background reinforced with practical skills that transfer into the modern workplace.

Extra-Curricular Opportunities

Students develop their skills in Early Years by providing support for the crèche facilities, volunteering in a health care setting and also at school Open Evenings.
